



Dress Code Policy



IN THE NAME OF ALLAH, THE MOST MERCIFUL, THE BENEFICENT

This policy relates to dress code when visiting AAIC premises. We request all members and visitors to comply with this policy.

- Islam prescribes a modest dress code for both men and women.
- Attire worn in mosques should be acceptable for both men and women.
- Men (and boys) shall wear loose, unrevealing clothing. It is most appropriate to wear long pants. Pants should extend past the knees.
- Sisters (and girls) shall be dressed in loose, unrevealing clothing. For example, loosely fitted garments that covers the whole body. It is compulsory for the believing women to be veiled modestly as prescribed in the Quran and to proudly identify with their Muslim faith.
- Both men and women should remove their footwear prior to entering the prayer areas and leave them in the shoe racks.
